I, Arun Kumar Jaiswal was appointed by the Board of Directors of Jayshree Chemicals Limited to act as the Scrutinizer for conducting the Postal Ballot voting process and E-voting process in respect of the following resolution:

#### Resolution:

Special Resolution pursuant to the provisions of Section 180(1)(a) of the Companies Act, 2013 and all other applicable provisions, if any, for authorizing the Board of Directors of the Company to convey, sell, transfer, assign or otherwise dispose of the Company's Chlor Alkali Manufacturing Facilities at Ganjam (Odisha) and Salt Manufacturing Facilities at Pundi Salt Factory at Nagarampalli village, District Srikakulam (Andhra Pradesh) on "as is where is" basis by way of slump sale to ADITYA BIRLA CHEMICALS (INDIA) LIMITED, for a lump-sum consideration of Rs. 212,00,00,000/- (Rupees Two Hundred Twelve Crores only) as a going concern in terms of the Resolution set out in the Notice dated 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2014 and the Explanatory Statement relating thereto.

The voting services were provided by Central Depository Services India Limited (CDSL).

I have downloaded the data of e-voting from CDSL's e-voting website <u>www.evotingindia.com</u> after the E-voting module was disabled by the Central Depository Services India Limited (CDSL) on 19<sup>th</sup> October, 2014 (6:00 P.M. IST).

The Postal Ballot Forms were kept under my safe custody in sealed and tamper proof ballot boxes before commencing the scrutiny of such Postal Ballot Forms.
